### **Reappointment**

Selectman Barra MOTIONED to reappoint Patricia Evans (U), as a member of the Beautification Committee for a term from September 7, 2015 through September 7, 2019 SECONDED by Selectman Strobel. Unanimous approval.

### **Public Comment**

Selectman Barra stated that the Town has received complaints about people coming out of Richardson drive unable to make a left. Senator Hartley's office was able to intervene and scheduled a meeting with DOT. As a result, DOT has given the Town permission to put hash marks on the road to alleviate traffic. The First Selectman requested that the letter received by the DOT be given to the press. First Selectman said that the entire Route 63/64 area is under design review for a massive upgrade to exit 17. New roads will be created and a new entrance to 84. All of the rock cut area will look totally different. He hasn't seen any of the design plans, but it will be a massive undertaking.

First Selectman said that roadside mower was involved in an accident. The operator of the machine was shaken up and the machine has extensive damage. He thanks the Town for the quick response. They are using a smaller mower and the damaged mower is in New York being repaired.
