JoAnn Lorusso said there will be monthly drawings provided for by local businesses. She explained the toddler group will receive a map, postcards and bookmarks. When the maps are completed they can be turned in and enter the drawing to win. June 19th at 2:00PM is the official kick off. Snacks will be served and a photo booth will be available. Pre-K through grade 5 will also

receive a map. JoAnn Lorusso said that a local high school student volunteered to design the digital cover for all the maps and she received credit for her course at Pomperaug Highschool. JoAnn Lorusso explained that the intent of the maps is for participants to explore different sections of the library.

JoAnn Lorusso said that Middlebury elementary school will have the first-grade field trip to the library in a few weeks. This gives the library an opportunity to promote what it has to offer. She said that 50 plus library cards will be issued.

JoAnn Lorusso said the library will start their summer hours from Memorial Day until Labor Day. The hours will be the same, but the library will be closed on Saturday.
