Call to Order with Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Mrs. Smith with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of February 13, 2018 Minutes –

Mr. Vaccarelli MOTIONED to approve the Minutes of the February 13, 2018 Meeting, SECONDED by Mrs. Fahey, unanimous approval.

Trustee Reports

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Mr. Stowell submitted a Treasurer's Report for February and March to each Trustee Member.

February - There was \$100.00 deposited in the Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities accounts during the period February 1, 2018 through February 28, 2018 from the sale of one regular 4 x 8 brick. There were no expenditures during this period. Total Brick Sales to date = \$50,795.00, Total Expenses to date = \$29,111.45, Balance in Fund 61 (Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities account) = \$21,683.55.

March - There was \$59.00 expended from the Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities accounts during the period March 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018 for a brick order of one regular 4 x 8 brick from Polar Engraving. Total Brick Sales to date = \$50,795.00, Total Expenses to date = \$29,170.45, Balance in Fund 61 (Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities account) = \$21,624.55

In response to Mrs. Fahey, Mr. Stowell explained the normal procedure when ordering bricks. A brick order under five (5) will include an extra fee for engraving. The \$59.00 engraving fee noted in his Treasurer's Report was for one brick. The order was processed since the initial brick order was submitted back in November of 2017.

Mr. Desmarais MOTIONED to accept the Treasurer's Report as submitted, SECONDED by Mr. Clark, unanimous approval.

To update the board members, Mr. Stowell noted the claim he filed with the State of Connecticut back in January on behalf of the Middlebury Public Library for the Exxon Mobil Stock Dividend was processed and is now complete (\$67.20).

<u>Secretary's Report</u> – None

<u>Director's Report</u> – Mrs. LoRusso confirmed that all Board Members received via email the attached Director's Report. February and March 2018 Statistics, April 2018 Library Programs and Services and Upcoming Events were briefly discussed. The decrease in the March Children's Programs was a result of cancellations due to inclement weather.

Science in Motion - the Science Center will be coming back for Science in Motion during the Region 15 Spring break (April 16 – April 20). Extra family oriented programs have been added for that time period.

The Score Workshop – Starting and Managing a Successful Non-profit Organization scheduled for Thursday, April 19th is at no cost.

Passports on Wheels - Representatives from the US Postal Service will set up in the Larkin Room. Photos can be taken, as well as applications and passport fees. This "community service" event also took place last year and had a very good turnout.

Mobile Printing - This new service was recently added. Patrons can now print from any device utilizing the appropriate app (instructions attached). This app will enable a device to communicate with the library printer/copier. Print jobs are held in a print queue until the appropriate fee is paid to a library staff member. This new service so far is popular among students, tutors and those who simply wish to use their own lap tops.

Mr. Clark MOTIONED to approve the Director's Report, SECONDED by Mr. Desmarais, unanimous approval.

Old Business – Progress on brick sales

Mrs. Smith initiated a brief discussion regarding ways to promote and increase sales. Mrs. Fahey and Mrs. LoRusso presented one order each. Handouts and materials have been posted around town. Newly designed folders with order forms are being displayed at numerous businesses / banks.

New Business – Lower level rental space

Mrs. Smith informed the Board that the Town has received a proposal to rent the lower level of the library. The Board of Selectmen and Attorney D'Angelo are currently reviewing it. The approval procedure, utilities etc. were briefly discussed. Mr. Vaccarelli will oversee and monitor signage details. Mr. Stowell wished to state for the record that any monies received or expended as a result of any lease agreement are not charged to the general library fund. There is a separate income and expense account set up for this sole purpose. It was also noted that Friends of the Middlebury Public Library Inc. is now sponsoring "monthly" book sales rather than "yearly". A monthly book sale enables easier oversight and organization of book donation inventory.


