### Call to Order with Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Mrs. Smith with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approval of March 12, 2019 Meeting Minutes** – Mr. Stowell MOTIONED to approve the Minutes of the March 12, 2019 Meeting as submitted, SECONDED by Mr. Desmarais, unanimous approval.

## **Trustee Reports**

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Mr. Stowell submitted the Treasurer's Report to each Trustee Member. There was no activity in the Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities accounts during the period March 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019. Total Brick Sales to date = \$52,060.00, Total Expenses to date = \$22,449.45, Balance in Fund 61 (Brick Sales and Room Naming Opportunities account) = \$22,610.55.

Mr. Desmarais MOTIONED to approve the Treasurer's Report as submitted, SECONDED by Mrs. Fahey, unanimous approval.

## Secretary's Report – None

**Director's Report** – Mrs. LoRusso confirmed that all Board Members received within their packet the attached Director's Report, Statistics for March 2019 and April Library Programs and Services and Upcoming Events. The Study Room usage continues to be very active during afternoon hours. It was used 86 times with 141 participants during March.

April 8<sup>th</sup> through April 13<sup>th</sup> is National Library Week. Patrons and visitors are being asked to write on post-it notes what they love about their Library and can been seen throughout the building.

Region 15 School Spring Break is April 15<sup>th</sup> through April 18<sup>th</sup>. Various events and activities for all age groups which are community and family oriented are being offered free of charge. Middlebury is working with Region 15 in a collaborated effort to offer additional programming. The Region is attempting to put together a "community event" between Southbury and Middlebury based on "diversity and inclusion". Mrs. LoRusso, First Selectman Edward B. St. John and Police Chief Dabbo attended a recent meeting. It has been suggested that both Libraries do some type of "community read". Mrs. LoRusso is in close contact with the Assistant Superintendent and will provide further details as they become available.

Mrs. LoRusso reminded the board that Middlebury already does "community read". She further noted Middlebury has already decided this summer's community read will be based on Nassau's 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary (50<sup>th</sup> for man on the moon). This theme will provide for many programs and events geared towards the celebration of space and Nassau's Anniversary. The community book chosen will be "Hidden Figures" (influence of women). This and other books will be available in June, discussions in July and ultimately end with a movie.

United States Postal Service Passport on Wheels will take place April  $23^{rd}$  from 12 - 4 p.m. The Watertown Post Office Branch will be on premises. Applications for new passports or the renewal of existing passports will be accepted. Passport photos may be taken. Those interested are encouraged to download and complete applicable forms prior to this event. This service was provided last year and was well received.

*Friends of the Middlebury Public Library, Inc.* Memorandum of Understanding (attached) – Mrs. LoRusso noted that a new signature page is provided. Mrs. Fahey is a newer member of this board and Friends, Inc. also has new members. (Board Members present proceeded to sign said memorandum).

*Lower Level Storage Area* – April 9, 2019 is the revised letter (attached). A brief discussion took place regarding the procedures. Motion was made by Mr. Desmarais to adopt the Lower Level Storage Area Procedure with the addition of the following sentence to item 6) "**Exceptions may be granted as needed and require prior written authorization from the Library Director**", Seconded by Mrs. Fahey, Unanimous approval.

#### Memorandum of Understanding

#### The Friends of the Middlebury Public Library, Inc. and the Middlebury Public Library

The following will constitute an operating agreement between the Friends of the Middlebury Public Library, Inc. and the Middlebury Public Library. It will stand until and unless it is modified by mutual agreement of the Friends executive board and the Middlebury Public Library. The Friends mission is to raise money and public awareness in the community to support the services and programs of the Library. As a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, however, it is a legally distinct entity and is not a part of the library.

The Library agrees to inform the Friends of the goals and direction of the Library for future funding.

The Library agrees to provide public space for Friends membership brochures and promotional materials.

The Library agrees to provide the Friends with the designated space in the lower level of the Library for book storage, sorting, and office needs under the adopted guidelines dated January 13, 2015.

The Friends agree to publicly support the library and its policies.

The Friends agree to include the library's liaison at all Friends' meetings.

The Friends agree that any monies raised will be spent exclusively for library programs, services, and other library defined needs per the Library Director. Disclosure of assets will be provided when requested by the Library's Board of Trustees.

The Friends agree that the Library Director has the final say in accepting or declining any and all gifts made to the library.

The Friends agree to engage in advocacy efforts on behalf of the library under the guidance of the Library and the Library's Board of Trustees.

The Friends agree to provide a current copy of the Friends Bylaws.

The Friends agree that if they cease to actively fundraise and promote the library, they will disband, allowing for a new Friends group to be established in the future.

Dear Friends of the Middlebury Public Library, Inc.:

The following procedures have been adopted by the Library Board of Trustees to secure safety and comfort, while maintaining efficient operation of the Library's Lower Storage Area facility and consideration to all involved.

Adherence to these procedures is mandatory. Any violation will result in loss of the use of the above mentioned facility.

- 1) All entryways and exits should be kept free of obstructions at all times.
- 2) All books and other materials should be kept off of the floor at all times. Exceptions may be granted as needed and require prior written authorization from the Library Director.
- 3) Movement of library equipment or furnishings require prior written authorization from the Library Director.
- 4) Users of the facility will be responsible for all trash removal after each use.
- 5) There is only 1 access key, located at the information desk, to be given to the Friends of Middlebury Public Library, Inc., and under no circumstances shall this key be duplicated or be removed from the premises.
- 6) Lower level access is only available during library hours.
