Transfer Station Hours of Operation

Tuesday thru Friday - 7:00 a.m to 2:45 p.m

Saturday - 7:30am – 3:15pm

Closed - Sunday, Monday and holidays

No charge for disposal of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) and recycling of the following:

1. Cardboard, newspapers and inserts, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, white and color paper, shoe boxes, computer paper, cereal boxes
2. All #1-#2 plastic containers under 3 gallons (*no caps*)
3. Aluminum, steel, tin & food trays, foil and cans
4. Plastic beverage & food containers #3-#7 up to 3 liters
5. Milk and juice cartons, juice boxes
6. Glass food and beverage jars, bottles and jugs
7. Large plastic items such as toys, recycling bins, coolers, baskets, containers & buckets
8. Scrap metal; Tin, white metal, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, items made primarily from metal
9. Motor oil, home heating oil, transmission oil, cooking oil, hydraulic oil, diesel, kerosene
10. Antifreeze
11. Automotive batteries, tractor batteries, motorcycle batteries
12. Clothes
13. Electronics; computers, monitors, printers, TVs, VCRs, DVDs, Copiers, fax machines, video game machines, iPods, iPads, PDAs, modems, keyboards, mouse to computer, stereo equipment, telephones, cell phones, cameras, tablets and ebooks, microwaves and other small appliances
14. Universal waste; light bulbs, fluorescent lamps, ballasts, rechargeable batteries

Fees are charged for disposal of these items

Bulky waste and C&D shall be weighed and charged a minimum fee of \$5 for up to 200 pounds **or** loads weighing over 200 pounds will be charged 5 cents per pound.

1. Mattresses or box springs are charged \$20 for each item. (*also includes crib mattresses*)
2. Sleeper sofas are charged for the weight of the sofa **PLUS** \$20 for the mattress.
3. Tires are charged as follows:
 - a. Up to 18" = \$5
 - b. Over 18" – 22" = \$10
 - c. NO large truck or heavy equipment tires accepted
4. Devices containing FREON = A/C units, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers are charged \$10 per unit.
5. 20lb Propane Tanks (*only*) = \$3.00 each. **NO larger propane tanks accepted!**
6. Small Helium Tanks = \$1.00 each

Unacceptable Waste

The following materials are NOT ACCEPTED at the Middlebury Transfer Station

Infectious or medical wastes, ammunition or other explosives, paint, sewage waste or sludge, sealed containers, animal carcasses, radioactive material, liquid or slurry waste of any kind regardless of packaging or labeling, bricks, blocks, boulders, rocks, stones, dirt, tree stumps, or other non-combustible materials, any containers that hold or once held hazardous material, any material deemed hazardous including but not limited to gasoline, pesticides & herbicides, chemicals, and mercury containing products.
